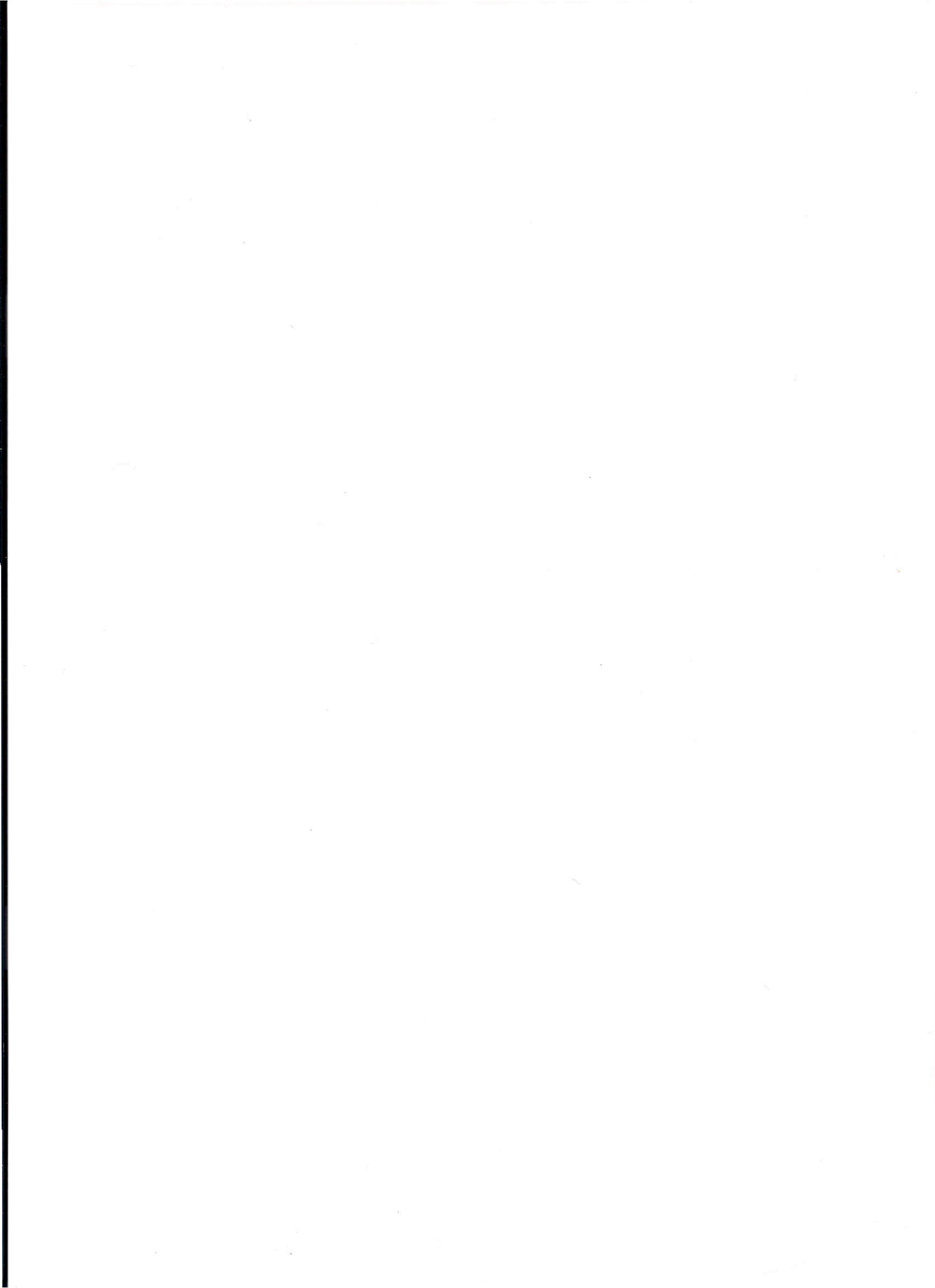

Steps 1 - 5 must be completed before the school office will schedule an appointment with the



Administrator for an interview. Interviews will be scheduled no sooner than 24 hours from the time steps 1 - 5 are completed. Scheduling an interview does not assure acceptance to the school. Students have not completed the application process for admission until an interview is held.

Your application fee of \$30 covers the review of your child's application and is non-refundable. The testing fee of \$50 is also non-refundable. The results of that test will not be made available for distribution. The entrance test determines the ability to be placed in the school, and a student who does not meet the minimum standard set by the school for the test will not be admitted.

All new students transferring in from out of state are required to submit a Florida Physical Form on the correct Florida form. This must be submitted prior to the scheduling of an interview.

Prior to attending the interview, please review our *Home and School Handbook*, making note of any questions you may have. The administrator who interviews you and your child will be glad to address any questions you may have regarding Ocala Christian Academy as part of the interview session. When scheduling an interview, you should plan for the session to last approximately 1 1/2 hours.

Once your child has been accepted into Ocala Christian Academy, he/she will need to be registered. A student's place in the classroom is not guaranteed until the registration form and the registration fee are submitted. Available classroom space is not held while waiting for this to be done. The registration fee and the book fee are both non-refundable. It is recommended that you come to the interview prepared to complete the registration process.

Ocala Christian Academy offers a quality Christian education from three year old kindergarten through the twelfth grade. OCA is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International, which as an accrediting agency is recognized by the Florida Department of Education and by the Florida Association of Nonpublic Schools.

Ocala Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, nationality and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school.
